## CONTRIBUTING OIL RECEIVED IN THE CALENDAR YEAR 2019

*(as reported by 31 December 2020)*

### INTRODUCTION

The 1992 Fund Convention and the Supplementary Fund Protocol require that all Member States report each year to the Director of the IOPC Funds the name and address of any person (i.e. company or entity) in that State liable to pay contributions to the 1992 Fund and/or to the Supplementary Fund, as well as the quantity of contributing oil received by each of these persons in the preceding year. The Funds' Internal Regulations require that the reports should be submitted no later than 30 April each year. Member States in which no person is liable to pay contributions to the 1992 Fund and/or the Supplementary Fund should notify the Director that this is the case. The IOPC Funds' Secretariat encourages all Member States to register to provide their information on oil receipts using the Online Reporting System (ORS), where they can also access contact details for contributors and historical oil data for their State.
