# PROVISIONAL AGENDA FOR THE MARCH 2021 SESSIONS OF THE IOPC FUNDS' GOVERNING BODIES

Monday, 29 March to Wednesday, 31 March 2021 to be held remotely via KUDO

### 1 Introduction

1.1 This document contains a provisional timetable and agenda for the March 2021 sessions of the IOPC Funds' governing bodies. The following sessions of the governing bodies will be convened:

- 1.2 The meeting will be held remotely via KUDO from Monday, 29 March 2021 to Wednesday, 31 March 2021. The working hours each day will be from 11.00 am to 2.00 pm (UTC+1)<sup><1</sup>, with one 15-minute break. Quorum for each of the governing bodies is established at the opening of the sessions on Monday at 11.00 am and therefore, delegates are requested to be logged into KUDO by that time.
- 1.3 Important information about the presentation of credentials and notifications, and registration for the virtual meeting is provided at Annex I. Please note that only those delegates who have registered and submitted credentials (if required) in advance of the meeting will be sent a link and joining instructions to the virtual meeting. Further details on technical recommendations for participating in the virtual meeting will be issued shortly in document IOPC/MAR21/1/4.
- 1.4 A list of Member States, observer States and intergovernmental and non-governmental organisations which hold observer status with the IOPC Funds is provided at Annex II.
- 1.5 The Director, in consultation with the Chairs, has prepared a provisional timetable and agenda found below. ## INFORMATION ON CREDENTIALS AND REGISTRATION TO THE MARCH 2021 MEETING OF THE IOPC FUNDS' GOVERNING BODIES

### 1 <u>Credentials and notifications</u>

1.1 In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, credentials or notifications are required in respect of sessions of each of the following governing bodies for representatives, alternates and other persons designated by governments and organisations to attend the meeting:

- 1.2 Credentials and notifications should be addressed to the <u>Director of the IOPC Funds</u> (i.e. not to the Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization (IMO).
- 1.3 Detailed guidance in respect of the form and content of credentials and notifications is given in circular IOPC/2015/Circ.4 which is available on the Document Services website. In this context, delegates are reminded that if credentials are not issued by the Head of State, the Head of Government, the Minister of Foreign Affairs or the Ambassador/High Commissioner, a letter from the appropriate authority appointing the person authorised to issue the credentials for sessions of the IOPC Funds' governing bodies should be provided to the Director of the IOPC Funds.

### 2 <u>Credentials for remote sessions</u>

- 2.1 Following the process noted by the governing bodies at their first remote meeting in December 2020, for practical reasons, it would be highly appreciated that delegations submit credentials via the online registration system or by email in advance of the meeting, and no later than **Friday, 12 March 2021.**
- 2.2 The Secretariat will do all it can to facilitate participation of delegations who submit credentials up to the opening day of the sessions, however, late submissions may lead to delays in providing links to access the KUDO platform on time for the opening of the sessions.
